

# Nordia 2011 Philatelic Seminar

A Philatelic Seminar with four one-hour presentations will be arranged in Nordia 2011, the Nordic exhibition to be held in Jyväskylä, Finland, next April.

The Seminar day is **Sunday 3 April 2011**. The first session (in English) will be held at 10:00-12:00 and the second session (in Finnish) at 15:00-17:00, both of them in the exhibition venue, Jyväskylä Fair Centre, meeting room "Felix" on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor close to the Fair Restaurant.

The Seminar is **open for all interested**. The four presentations are especially directed to the Nordia 2011 exhibitors, all exhibitors who have an exhibit in a stage of development, everybody interested in building up an exhibit, as well as for jurors and jury apprentices of every level.

**Due to room restrictions, the maximum number of participants is 30 persons only. That is why a binding beforehand booking is requested. It is absolutely necessary also for those Jurors and Jury Apprentices serving in Nordia 2011 and wishing to participate, to send their beforehand booking.**

## THE PROGRAMM - SUNDAY 3 APRIL

- Presentation 1 / 10:00-11:00

### ***Brian Trotter: Evaluating Traditional Exhibits (in English)***

The first speaker is Mr. *Brian Trotter*, RDP, of United Kingdom, one of the most experienced FIP jurors worldwide with competence in various exhibition classes. His presentation treats evaluating Traditional Exhibits (in English).

In Nordia 2011, Mr. Trotter also serves in the Jury, with a task of team leader in Traditional Philately Class.

### ***Wolf Hess: Evaluating Postal History Exhibits (in English)***

The second speaker is Mr. *Wolf Hess*, RDP, of Germany, also one of the most experienced FIP jurors with competence in Postal History and Thematic Classes. His presentation treats evaluating Postal History Exhibits (in English).

In Nordia 2011, Mr. Hess also serves in the Jury, with a task of team leader in Postal History Class.

After the first session, there is a **Luch pause** at 12:00-13:00 followed by **The Jury Feedback** for the Nordia 2011 exhibitors in the exhibition venue at 13:00-15:00. Jury Feedback is for the Nordia 2011 exhibitors only. No beforehand booking is needed for that occasion.

**Jussi Murtosaari: Making an Exhibit Introductory Page (in Finnish)**

The Seminar continues with the second session at 15:00, entirely in Finnish.

The third speaker is Mr. *Jussi Murtosaari* of Finland, an accredited Nordic juror for Traditional Philately. His presentation treats making an introductory page for philatelic exhibit.

**Jukka Mäkinen: Making a Synopsis (in Finnish)**

The fourth and last one speaker is Mr. *Jukka Mäkinen* of Finland, an accredited Nordic juror for Thematic Philately with National competence to Revenues. His presentation treats making a Synopsis for philatelic exhibit.
